

Hildebrand Ranch Trail Race Report

November can be dicey, especially in Colorado. Indian summer, blizzard, monsoon, frost, wind – no one would have been surprised by any of this on any given November day. Although we couldn't be surprised, we were very grateful for the beautiful, calm, sunny day with temperatures in the mid-50's we were given for the race this year. It would be hard to imagine a prettier day in November.

In this, the fifth running of the Hildebrand Ranch Trail Race, not only was the weather kind to us but the course was in great shape despite some rain earlier in the week. There were no puddles or sticky mud and the ground was just a bit damp in spots on the single track sections. The course for this year's race remained the same as for the prior years, and despite some warning signs that were posted regarding possible plague among the prairie dog population inhabiting the southern portion of the open space, no prairie dogs molested us.

Before starting the race, a special presentation was made to Joe Baird of a gift card as a small Thank You for his many years of service to the club, along with a nice round of applause from the gathered runners and racewalkers.

Benefiting from the wonderful weather and course conditions, Chris Knott blasted out to the overall win in a time of 40:35, a new course record by 35 seconds. Christine Adamowski took the title for the women in 48:34, her third victory in the five years the club has held this event. Notable also was Ken "Stonewall" Green, who at age 85 was our oldest finisher and who upon crossing the finish line was given a rousing ovation by the runners gathered at the finish.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the named race directors were unable to fulfill their duties this year. Instead, the CMRA board stepped in and took over race director duties, primarily Jen Forker, Ed Youngberg and Rob Fisher. These folks assumed coordinator responsibilities, seamlessly arranging for volunteers and assuring all aspects of the race functioned well. Keith Johnson obtained the Jefferson County race permit before bowing out, and Tom Chambers obtained the South Suburban Parks race permit. Scott McFarlane laid out the course and (non-board members) Lori Nakauchi and **others** helped with sweeping the course after the race. Joe Baird coordinated timing and the finish line, with assistance from Rob Fisher, Joe Sanchez and **others**. Connie Ahrnsbrak and Tom Chambers handled the presentation of awards and the raffle of a large array of gifts. Course marshals were **2-3 people** at the road crossing and **3-4 children** at the water station. **I'm sure there are some others I'm overlooking.** A big Thank You goes out to everyone who helped pull the race together.

Boulder Running Company and Runners Roost – Lakewood provided gift cards. The Colfax Marathon provided a race entry and tee shirts. **Someone** provided clothing, **someone else** provided **watches(?)**, and Great Harvest Bread provided a nice selection of breads and other baked goods. Club member Matt Barnes set up his chiropractic bench at start/finish area and provided diagnostic analyses and suggested treatments for runners.
